



## Clariane becomes the first company in its sector to be certified Top Employer Europe



Clariane has made its human resources policy one of the key components of its At your side corporate project, with the aim of making the Group's various entities benchmark employers in their respective sectors.

Receiving the Top Employer 2024 award at European level, a first for a group in the healthcare and medical-social sector, marks a major milestone for the Group.

Five of the Group's seven countries where the company is present have been honored: Germany for the 4<sup>th</sup> year running, France for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year running, Belgium and Italy for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time and the UK for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.

In line with its mission of taking care of each person's humanity in times of vulnerability, Clariane has made human resources strategy the cornerstone of its At your side corporate project. Obtaining Top Employer Europe certification is a recognition of the in-depth work carried out since 2019 by the teams in charge of human resources, operational teams and employee representative bodies around three main axes:

- ✓ The human resources policy implemented on a day-to-day basis in our facilities, to promote health and safety in the workplace and enable the successful integration of each employee, in line with the values of trust, initiative and responsibility and the humanistic approach to care that underpin the Group's project;
- ✓ Skills development, notably through the Clariane Universities network, which brings together all the training courses offered by the Group (continuing education, resulting in a certification or diploma) in every country;
- ✓ Promoting high-quality social dialogue at all levels of the company.

The Top Employers Institute is the international certification organization that recognizes excellence in HR practices. This certification is based on a survey of 350 HR best practices and 20 themes analyzing in depth the quality of a company's HR processes. The Top Employers is itself audited by an independent third-party organization.

For Sophie Boissard, Chief Executive Officer of Clariane: « Assuming our mission of "taking care of each person's humanity in times of vulnerability" also means working alongside our teams to facilitate their work and create the conditions for each of our employees to develop and flourish in their profession. For us, symmetry of attention is of the utmost importance; it's by taking care of our employees that we can ensure that our patients and residents are well looked after. We are honored to be the first company in our sector to obtain European Top Employer certification. »
